Note: Abstract Submission is available only to registered delegates. Kindly follow the guidelines of submission; else, your request may not be considered.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES IN RESCARE 2024: For E-Poster & Oral Presentation

- Abstracts are invited for **E-Poster and Oral** presentations from registered delegates only for **RESCARE 2024**.
- Categories for abstract submission under the Faculty of Health Sciences are as follows: Biological Sciences, Health Sciences, Sport Sciences, Medical Sciences, Health Care, and Culinary Arts.
- Those delegates wishing to submit an abstract are requested to register before abstract submission to avoid last-minute confusion. The abstract will not be considered for review and further presentation in the event of a registration failure.
- The official language of the Conference is English. The editorial committee will not process abstracts, which are not in English.
- Font: Times New Roman; Font size:12
- The abstract submitted must not have been presented at any previous conclave/ conference/seminar or published in any scientific journal. If found to be already published/presented, the abstract will be rejected. AI generated abstracts will be rejected.
- The first abstract will be accepted for review if a similar abstract paper has been submitted more than once.
- Each presenting author may submit only ONE abstract.
- Abstracts should be submitted through the email available on the Conference website (<https://www.iarc.in/rescare/>) (Email for abstract submission: rescare2024@gmail.com). Abstracts sent by any other mode (hard copy, post or fax etc.) would not be processed by the scientific committee and will not be reviewed or acknowledged.

Abstract Format

- **Title:** Short and concise that indicates the content of the abstract.
- **Abstract frame:** Abstracts must be structured as follows:
Experimental/Clinical research: Introduction/Background, Methodology, Results, Discussion / Conclusion / Future Directions/ Keywords
Case report/series: Keywords, Introduction, Case(s) history/description, Discussion, Conclusion
- **Word limit:** 350 words for both experimental and clinical research as well as for case reports/ series **without** any diagrams, charts, footnotes, or references, excluding the title and authors and affiliation.
- **Safety/Ethics/Clinical trials:** All abstracts submitted for oral and E-Poster presentations must provide room for ethical consideration for the conducted **clinical trials/** experimental study (clinical as well as preclinical)/case report under the methods section.

Presenting Author

- The presenting author must be a registered delegate.
- Presenting author's name and affiliation(s) should clearly be stated. The name of the authors should be in initials with the surname. Ex: Ramesh Chandra Misra: **R C Mishra**
- The name of presenting author should be in **Bold** and Underlined
- The presenting author should submit an abstract.
- The editorial committee will communicate with the presenting author through the **e-mail** address from which the abstract (presenting author) is sent.
- In case the presenting author is not the corresponding author, details of the corresponding author (such as name with an Asterix (*)) against it, affiliation, and email id) must be mentioned on the E-Poster. For oral presentations, the details of the corresponding authors could be provided at the under of the presentation under acknowledgement/thank you slide.

Abstract Submission Closing Dates

- The abstract submissions will close on **30th August, 2024** at midnight Indian Standard Time.

Review and Acceptance of Abstracts

- The abstract will be reviewed by a panel of reviewers and will be accepted for a E-POSTER/ORAL presentation or sent back to the presenting author for modifications. The authors will be notified of the outcome of the review process in due course.

- The **RESCARE 2024** editorial committee reserves the right to change the presentation mode and even the categories as deemed fit.
- The decision of the editorial committee of **RESCARE 2024** will be regarded as final.
- **Publication Rights:** By submitting an abstract, the authors give the right to the conference organizers to publish the abstract in an abstract book/CD. The presenting author must enter the co-authors' names and affiliations when submitting the abstract online.
- **Guidelines for the Oral and E-Poster presentation will be sent to you based on whether your E-Poster is selected for Oral or E-Poster presentation**

Guidelines for E-Poster presentation

The dimensions and specification of the E-Poster must be as follows:

Pixels: Minimum recommended size (format W x H) is 1125 x 2000px and maximum is 2250 x 4000px.

In inches/cm: 18"/45.72cm width and 32"/81.28cm height

Format: 9:16

Minimum Font Size: 10pt

DPI 300 pixels/inch

File Size: Maximum file size without the video is 5MB, including the video is 40MB.

File Format: PDF (.pdf)

Media: Images/photos, graphs and tables can be included in the e-poster.

Multimedia: Videos can be included in the e-poster. (in order to embed movies inside PDF please use Adobe Acrobat Pro and only mp4 files are accepted encoded with h264 codec)

Maximum 4 videos per e-poster.

1. Title: Times New Roman, Font size- 45-50 pts, Bold

2. Author(s): Full name in Times New Roman, Font size- 45-50 pts, Bold and Italics.
3. Author(s) Affiliation: Name of the Institute, Designation and contact details in Times New Roman, Font size- 45-50 pts [Indicate the corresponding author by asterix (*) and the presenting author in bold and underled].
4. The E-Poster should include Abstract/Background (preferably short), Methodology (preferably short), Results (preferably elaborate), Discussion/Future Directions (preferably short), Graphical Summary (if applicable), Ethics and Funding statements (if applicable) and not more than 3 references, Font size- 35-40 pts.
5. Including tables, graphs, images, and QR codes (3 min Audio File) is highly appreciated.
6. The E-Poster can be prepared electronically using Microsoft PowerPoint or any designing software.
7. At the bottom of each E-Poster, following line should be added “**RESCARE 2024**” [Font size- 60-65 pts].

Guidelines for Oral Paper Presentation

Total seven slides (excluding the Title and Acknowledgement/Thank you slides) covering the following points

1. Title: Times New Roman, Font size- 25 pts, Bold
2. Author(s): Full name in Times New Roman, Font size- 18 pts, Bold and Italics
3. Author(s) Affiliation: Name of the Institute, Designation and contact details in Times New Roman, Font size- 16 pts (Indicate the corresponding author by * and the presenting author in bold and underlined)
4. Introduction/Rationale of study, Methodology, Results, Discussion/Way forward/Novelty of the study and not more than
5. The inclusion of tables, graphs, and images is highly encouraged.
6. The presentation should be made in a PPT format.
7. Time details: 10 mins for the presentation and 5 mins for the Q-A session.
