

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES (RESCARE 2026)

E-Poster & Oral Presentation

- ***Only RESCARE 2026 registered delegates are invited to submit abstracts for oral presentations and e-posters.***
- Delegates who wish to submit an abstract ***must first register for both the conference and the abstract submission.*** This step is essential to avoid any last-minute confusion.
- Please note that there is an abstract submission fee of Rs. 300. If registration is not completed successfully, the abstract will be disqualified from review and presentation.
- The official language of the Conference is English. The scientific committee will not process abstracts that are not in English.
- Font: Times New Roman; Font size:12; Line Spacing: 1.5
- AI-assisted language editing is allowed, but AI-generated scientific content is prohibited. Authors are required to take full responsibility for the content of their submissions.
- The abstract must be submitted together with a plagiarism report. The overall similarity index must be < 10%.
- The plagiarism report should be generated using a recognized plagiarism detection software, such as Turnitin, iThenticate, Ouriginal (Urkund), or an equivalent tool. Please also specify whether the similarity index is calculated after excluding references, bibliographies, and quoted text.
- The abstract must be submitted in a Word document for the initial review.
- After acceptance of the abstract, E-poster or oral presentation slides can be prepared as per the decision of the scientific team, which will be communicated to the participants.
- Each presenting author can submit only one abstract.
- Abstract submissions must be sent via the email address provided on the conference website
- Email for abstract submission: rescare2026@yenepoya.edu.in
- Please note that abstracts submitted through any other method (hard copy, postal mail, fax, etc.) will not be processed or reviewed by the scientific committee and will not receive any acknowledgment.

Abstract Format

1. Title: Short and concise, indicating the content of the abstract.
2. Abstract frame: Abstracts must be structured as follows: Introduction/Background, Methodology, Results, Conclusion / Future Directions, Keywords
3. Word limit: 300 words
4. Do not include any tables or graphs in the abstract submission.
5. Ethical approval must be provided where applicable, along with the ethical clearance number as per the institutional protocol.
6. Abstracts submitted without a valid ethical clearance number will not be considered for review when ethical approval is required.

Guidelines for the Presenting Author

1. The presenting author must be a registered delegate.
2. Presenting author's name and affiliation(s) should clearly be stated. The name of the presenting author should be in Bold and Underlined.
3. The presenting author should submit an abstract with the subject name: **ABSTRACT_RESCARE 2026_NAME**
4. The scientific committee will communicate with the presenting author through the e-mail address from which the abstract (presenting author) was sent.
5. Abstract Submission Closing Dates: The abstract submissions will close on **1st September 2026**, at midnight Indian Standard Time (IST).

Review and Acceptance of Abstracts

1. A panel of reviewers will evaluate each abstract. Based on the reviewers' recommendations, the abstract may be accepted for an oral presentation or e-poster presentation, returned to the authors for revision, or rejected. Authors will be notified of the outcome of the review process in due course. The decision of the scientific committee of RESCARE 2026 will be regarded as final.
2. The presenting author must include the names and affiliations of all co-authors in the submitted abstract document.

E-poster/oral presentation format will be sent to the participants after acceptance of the abstract.

Guidelines for E-Poster presentation

The dimensions and specifications of the E-Poster must be as follows:

1. Pixels: Minimum recommended size (format W x H) is 1125 x 2000px and maximum is 2250 x 4000px; DPI 300 pixels/inch
2. In inches/cm: 18"/45.72cm width and 32"/81.28cm height.
3. Format: 9:16
4. Minimum Font Size: 10pt
5. File Size: Maximum file size without the video is 5MB, including the video is 40MB.
6. File Format: PDF (.pdf)
7. Media: Images/photos, graphs and tables can be included in the e-poster.
8. Title: Times New Roman, Font size- 45-50 pts, Bold
9. Author(s): Full name in Times New Roman, Font size- 45-50 pts, Bold and Italic.
10. Author(s) Affiliation: Name of the Institute, Designation and contact details in Times New Roman, Font size- 45-50 pts.
11. The E-Poster should include Abstract/Background, Methodology, Results, and Conclusion. Inclusion of tables, graphs, images, and QR codes is highly appreciated.
12. Reference - Not more than 3 references,
13. The E-Poster can be prepared electronically using Microsoft PowerPoint or any design software
14. Time details: 8 mins for the presentation and 2 mins for the Q-A session

Guidelines for Oral Paper Presentation

1. Total seven slides (excluding the Title and Acknowledgement slides) covering the following points: Introduction/Rationale of study, Methodology, Results, Way forward/Novelty of the study
2. Title: Times New Roman, Font size- 25 pts, Bold
3. Author(s): Full name in Times New Roman, Font size- 18 pts, Bold and Italics
4. Author(s) Affiliation: Name of the Institute, Designation and contact details in Times New Roman, Font size- 16 pts.
5. The inclusion of tables, graphs, and images is highly encouraged.
6. The presentation should be made in a PowerPoint presentation format.
7. Time details: 8 mins for the presentation and 2 mins for the Q-A session
